- Shoes (no open toe shoes)

- Light Jacket or Heavy Coat (depending on weather)

- Sleeping Bag
- Sleeping Pad
- Camp Chair / Stool
- Pocket knife (ONLY if Totin' Chip is earned)
- Personal First Aid kit
- Water Bottle or Canteen
- Flashlight
- Extra Batteries
- Compass
- Toiletries (comb, toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, non-aerosol deodorant, etc.)
- Toilet Paper (Travel Size)
- Towel(s)
- Shower Shoes
- Watch
- Insect Repellent
- Sun Screen
- Drinking Cup
- Small notebook with Pen/Pencil

Long Term Camping (Summer Camp or Winter Camp)

- Substitute Backpack with Footlocker
- Cot
- Hydration Pack
- Camera (disposable kind ... not electronic)

Do Not Bring

- Sheath Knives
- Axes
- Hatchet
- ***ANY ELECTRONIC DEVICES***
- Water Guns
- Flammable Aerosol Products
